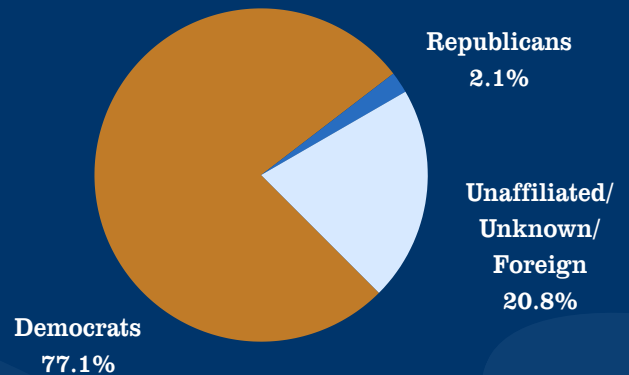


YALE CLASS DAY SPEAKERS

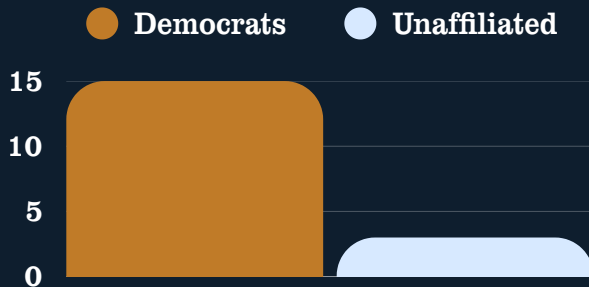
Since 1979, 37 of 48 (77%) Yale Class Day speakers were Democrats, 1 (2%) was a Republican, and 10 (21%) were unaffiliated, unknown, or foreign.

- Of the 48 Class Day speakers, 13 were Democratic politicians (Hillary Clinton counted for each speech), four were members of Democratic administrations, and three were Democratic activists.
 - Two additional speakers were world leaders from liberal political parties (they were not counted as Democrats).
- Only one speaker was a Republican politician and one a Republican administration member.
- One speaker served in both Democratic and Republican administrations and was counted as unaffiliated.

- Excluding those counted by political activity above, there were 15 speakers who were registered Democrats, three registered as unaffiliated, and no speakers registered as Republicans.

- Excluding donations by politicians, 99.2% of contributions have been to Democratic causes.
 - 23 speakers have contributed \$2 million to Democrats, including two with unknown registrations who donated exclusively or overwhelmingly to Democrats and were categorized as Democrats accordingly.
 - Five speakers have contributed \$16,539 to Republicans, only one of whom donated exclusively to Republicans.
